








Secure your Government grant now

Warmer Homes Heating & Renewables has secured funding for low income families and pensioners in receipt of qualifying benefits to put towards replacing old, broken or inefficient gas boilers. If you own your own home or privately rent a property (with your landlord's permission) you can apply for a grant.

How is it funded?

The ECO (Energy Company Obligation) Scheme is a Government run initiative which helps low income households reduce their energy bills. The funding comes from the large energy companies which are legally bound to meet fuel efficiency targets.

So do I qualify?

Step 1. Is your existing gas boiler, old (more than 10 years), broken or just very inefficient ?  Yes	Step 2. Are you a home owner or do you privately rent? (With your landlords permission)  Yes

Please note that, even if you do qualify, you may be required to make a contribution towards the new boiler. However your savings on your ongoing energy bills should offset that.
